3.0 OUR SERVICES

3.1 THE EXCEL SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICE

School Health Service is an essential component of the overall school program that supports the individual health and well-being of each student through quality nursing services provided by professional school nurses.

They are services provided through the school system to improve the health and well-being of children and in some cases, whole families and the broader community. These services have been developed in different ways around the globe but the fundamentals are constant: the early detection, correction, prevention or amelioration of disease, disability and abuse from which school aged children can suffer.

CATEGORIES OF SERVICES

3.1.1 SERVICES TAILORED FOR ADOLESCENT STUDENTS

School health services are an easy access point to health care for students. Our services tailored for adolescent students include:

- Health assessments and provision of information, advice, referrals and support for students.
- Support program which encourages the development of knowledge, skills and behaviour, and encourages the young person to deal with their health issue(s) and make healthy lifestyle choices. Individual students can seek information, guidance and support about a range of issues that may include:
 - coping with illness
 - anxiety
 - unhappy healthy eating and nutrition
 - healthy weight and body image
 - mental health and wellbeing
 - loss and grief problems at home
 - relationships and sexual health
 - smoking, alcohol and drug use and other adolescent health concerns.

3.1.2 SERVICES SPECIFIC TO PRIMARY SCHOOL CHILDREN

- All primary school children are offered a health assessment before the end of their first year of primary school. THE EXCEL School Health Nurse will seek consent and gain valuable knowledge from the school authorities and parents about their child's development prior to conducting health assessments of hearing and vision; and if needed, any other health and development assessment.
- If the child's teacher(s) have specific concerns at any point throughout primary school, an assessment can be conducted.
- The school authorities, teachers and parents are advised on assessment results and recommended actions or referrals.

3.2 BROAD RANGE OF SERVICES

3.2.1 SCHOOL HEALTH NURSING

THE EXCEL School Nurse is a valued member of the school team and contributes to the total education program. Regulations and school nursing guidelines are followed to address the health and safety of students receiving a public or private education. Our Nurse provides:

- quality, direct nursing services for chronic and episodic conditions
- health screenings and referrals
- health promotion for students and staff
- care coordination for students with chronic health conditions
- health service management
- a link to healthcare providers in the community
- easy first point of contact to health care for students.
- an on-site health resource for students, families and staff

OUR SCHOOL NURSE CERTIFICATION

It is expected that every public/private school in Nigeria have a full-time School Nurse. Our School Nurses working in public/private schools have the minimum hiring criteria, e.g. Registered Nurse license to practice in Nigeria and three years of supervised, clinical

experience. Furthermore, our School Nurses receive additional training to become more skilled in the area of school nursing services.

OUR SCHOOL NURSE PROFESSIONAL LEARNING COURSES

Professional Learning courses for The Excel School Nurses and Educators are available through The Excel Professional Development Management System. Courses include (but not limited to):

- Drug administration and control for school nurses
- Epinephrine for Anaphylaxis in Schools (EAS) for the School Nurse

3.2.2 PROVISION OF VARIOUS EQUIPMENTS

We provide various state-of-the-art equipments needed for quality school health services delivery such as:

- Various visual acuity test charts such as vision kits, flip charts and media, eye chart and eye chart cabinets, screening cards, color vision screenings, stereopsis
- Various vision screening accessories such as spot vision screeners, suresight vision screener, titmus vision screeners
- Hearing screening kits such as hearing screener, audiometer/hearing kits, Tympanometers, Noise dosimeters, Ear plugs and ear phones, hearing screening accessories.
- AEDs/CPR devices such as AEDs & Accessories, Training Manikins & classes, Resuscitaton & Oxygen Devices, CPR Products and devices

- School Safety Kits such as emergency & trauma kits/accessories, two-way radios, weather monitors, spine-boards & collars, fire prevention & treatment, stop the bleed, school lockdown products, evacuation equipments.
- Diagnostic and screening equipments such as vital sign equipments, vital sign monitor, vaginal illumination system, specula, spatula, scales & stadiometers
- First Aid Equipments such as adhesive & elastic bandages, examination gloves, wound care and wound cleaning materials, first aid kits, first aid tapes, hot & cold packs, sling & splints, crutches, wheelchairs, medical totes & bags, instruments
- Apparels & gifts such as cardigans & jackets, books
- Clinic/health room/sick bay furnishings such as appliances, flashlights/pen touches, furniture, containers & organizers, waste containers, stress relief, eye glasses etc

3.2.3 SCHOOL HEALTH AED PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

3.2.4 HEALTH AND WELLNESS PROGRAM

Goal: The goal of the Health and Wellness Program is to ensure each student optimizes healthy coping strategies, finds good balance and achieves academic success throughout schooling.

Mission: To encourage students to achieve and maintain a healthy lifestyle by balancing all aspects of their lives, to provide the skills for students to achieve academic success and to become positive role models in teaching wellness to their immediate family members and community at large.

The Health and Wellness Program is divided into five sections: Physical, Psychological, Academic, Social and Community. For each section, there are activities which promote health and self-care. Students participate on the planning committee for the Wellness program and assist in the coordination of social events, workshops, speakers and other relevant activities. Students become a “Health and Wellness Ambassador” by attending about 10 seminars over their 4-6 years in college. We believe in a student friendly approach to wellness. A healthy environment is one in which there is not only an absence of harmful conditions, but an abundance of health promoting ones.

Initiatives

Primary Interventions focus on the prevention of problems. For example, a focus on communication strategies during high stress periods, promotion of service and citizenship, and coaching.

Secondary Interventions aims to manage the symptoms of strain. For example, stress management programs such as relaxation techniques

Tertiary Interventions designed to help the individual who may need specialized input to deal with the strain for example, personal counseling.

The Wellness Program also includes an annual wellness week in January of each year. This wellness week includes daily wellness activities, seminars, free massages and healthy lifestyle resources. In addition, the wellness program presents on important wellness topics monthly. The topics and activities align with the physical, psychological, academic, social and community components of health. Workshops on various topics are also planned based on students’ interest.

3.2.5 HEALTH ASSESSMENT

We provide health assessment for vision, hearing, height, weight and general development issues. If required, we refer students to another health professional within the school health service or to other agencies for further assessment, tests, diagnosis, treatment or therapy.

3.2.6 SCHOOL IMMUNISATION PROGRAM

Protection produced by some vaccines will decline over time and booster doses may be needed to ensure high levels of protection are maintained (for example diphtheria, whooping cough and tetanus). A booster dose given in high school will provide protection over a longer

period of time. Also vaccines such as the human papilloma virus (HPV) are more effective if delivered at a specific age.

Vaccines delivered through The EXCEL School Program are made available at no cost under the National Immunisation Program of Nigeria. Our fully trained and qualified vaccination team visit all managed schools to deliver the program.

3.2.7 WORK WITH TEACHERS TO SUPPORT HEALTH EDUCATION SESSIONS.

We develop various approaches to partner with teachers on specific trainings to support their effort on various health education sessions for students.

3.2.8 PARENTING ADVICE

We offer parenting advice on each student health and wellness status to their respective parents. This is done at the approval of the school authorities to ensure strict confidence and privacy of students' data.

3.2.9 EMERGENCY SITUATIONS REQUIRING AN AMBULANCE

Schools are advised to have ambulance cover, as an ambulance will be called for students in an emergency situation, if deemed necessary.
